
- I care not for her.

- Mow you not the cause?




## Verb raising in English


- She may not be suitable.
- She is not suitable.
- She may not be enjoying syntax. [pragmatically anomalous, but syntactically fine.]
- She is not enjoying syntax.
- He may not have done it.
- He has not done it.



## Basic facts: The part of speech of if

- If we have the courage, we can change things.
- 2 I wonder  $\begin{cases} if \\ whether \end{cases}$  we have the courage.
- \* Whether we have the courage, we can change things.
- \* We have the courage, we can change things.

Comp	Feature
{if whether }	+ Q + Cond



#### Counterfactuals

- If we had the courage, we could change things.
- Had we the courage, we could change things.
- \* If had we the courage, we could change things.
